❖ Travelling to UCD

❖ Belfield Campus

Belfield, the main University College Dublin campus is located on a 132 hectare site, 4km south of Dublin city centre. The campus is an attractively landscaped complex of modern architectural buildings, accommodating student residences and leisure and sporting facilities. The UCD Michael Smurfit Graduate School of Business is located on the campus at Blackrock, County Dublin.

❖ By Plane

Dublin is served by Dublin International Airport, which is located north of Dublin City Centre. There are frequent connecting buses from the airport to the city centre, including a special shuttle service, Airlink.

❖ By Train

Dublin is served by two main railway stations: Connolly Station (north and south services) and Heuston Station (services to the west). It is a short walk from Connolly Station to O'Connell Street, where the Dublin Bus number 46A can be boarded for UCD. ❖ **By Bus**

Dublin Bus

Dublin Bus provides services to UCD. Journey time is 15-20 minutes. From the city centre north of the river Liffey the most convenient bus route is 39A which terminates in Belfield campus. Bus Éireann

Bus Éireann provides a nationwide bus service, with most major areas having a regular link to Dublin. The majority of Dublin services terminate in Busáras (Central Bus Station, Dublin). However, during peak hours, several Bus Éireann services from the Greater Dublin area directly serve UCD, Belfield Campus. For further information please visit www.buseireann.ie

❖ **By Taxi**

There are usually an adequate number of taxis in operation in the city centre at any given time. It is possible to hail a taxi from the street, but convenient taxi ranks are located on O'Connell Street, Middle Abbey Street, Dame Street and St Stephens Green. Dublin taxis also operate a call app 'HailO' which can be used to contact the nearest taxi to your location <https://www.hailoapp.com/ie/>

❖ **By Car**

UCD is within easy reach of the main ferry-ports at Dublin docks and Dun Laoghaire. Arriving from outside of Dublin by car on M50 exit at Junction 13 (Dun Laoghaire) and follow signs to Stillorgan (N11). Please note that limited pay parking is available for visitors to UCD campus in Belfield.
